



Annual audit for Maryland Healthy Kids EPSDT

Every year, UnitedHealthcare Community Plan of Maryland works with health care professionals to complete medical record reviews required by the Maryland Department of Health (MDH).

If you're selected for an audit, we'll look at your 2025 medical records to help make sure you're meeting MDH Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) requirements. To meet MDH standards, you must score at least 80% compared to the [Maryland Healthy Kids preventative schedule](#).

EPSDT audit process

There's no change in the process for 2026. We'll contact you soon to ask for documentation for specific patients. We'll review, audit and score the requested records. Then, our EPSDT quality nurse will share audit results with you.

- If you pass the audit, we'll send you the results and no further action will be required
- If you don't pass the audit, we'll send you the results and
 - We'll note where you didn't meet state standards
 - We'll do a follow-up audit and request new records, see results for reassessment process
