September is National Suicide Prevention Awareness Month. According to the Department of Veterans Affairs, seventeen (17) Veterans end their lives by suicide each day. The Department of Defense reports that 519 current service members died by suicide in 2021. Both of these alarming numbers indicate current and former service members die by suicide at a disproportionate rate compared to all adult suicides in the U.S. Texas is focused on ending the preventable tragedy of veteran suicides and, through Legislative action during the 88th Regular Session, has designated September 22 as Texas Veterans Suicide Prevention Day.
